Patient dissatisfaction and clinician burnout are rampant in our healthcare system. Patient-centered care and practitioner wellness are essential. In this course, students develop a humanistic practice philosophy. We analyze humanism in medicine focusing on two questions:

- 1) In what ways is our healthcare system dehumanizing? and
- 2) How can healthcare workers mediate this dehumanization?

While identifying barriers to humanizing medicine, we develop ways to maintain agency in practice. Clinician wellness is also heavily emphasized.
