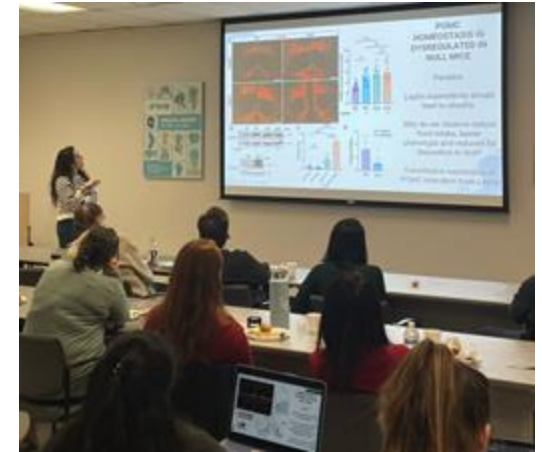


NeuroConnections

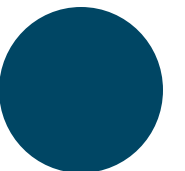
