




#### **NeuroConnections**


Who - GSO run by and for the Neuroscience PhD students, although all are welcome! Second year students are in charge of E-Board activities and creating events.

What - Regular seminars given by senior Neuroscience students detailing their research. All students and faculty are invited to attend and lunch is always included.

















