#### Internal and External

- Internal funding includes Rutgers support, such as funding from your graduate program
- External funding includes support from non-Rutgers funders

### **External Funding**

- Key factors: academic preparation and background, stage of study, career goals, area of study.
- Types of support: research grants and fellowships; writing fellowships; grants for travel, or specialized training.

### **Grants and Fellowships**

- Grants provide support for research-related expenses.
- Fellowships provide support for living expenses.


### **The Application Timeline**



- Apply the year before you need funding
- Begin to develop your application 6 months before the deadline
- Many of the deadlines fall between September and March, annually

### **Building Your Funding Plan**



### Find opportunities that meet your needs

Consider fit for each funding opportunity

Compare benefits provided versus your needs



### Create a schedule for applying to funding

Think about timing- deadlines, review process, dispersion of funds

Reflect on workload- ensure adequate time/energy to craft a competitive application



### Devise a timeline for each funding opportunity

Start process early
Review application
logistics/components
Build in time for feedback/revisions
