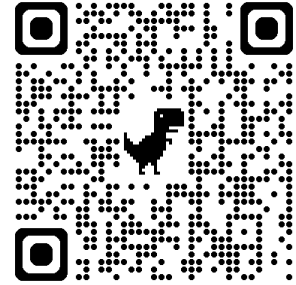

- Usually go by CETL, OTL, ITL, or some combination of the words “center”, “institute”, “learning”, “education”, “pedagogy” etc.
