NeuroConnections

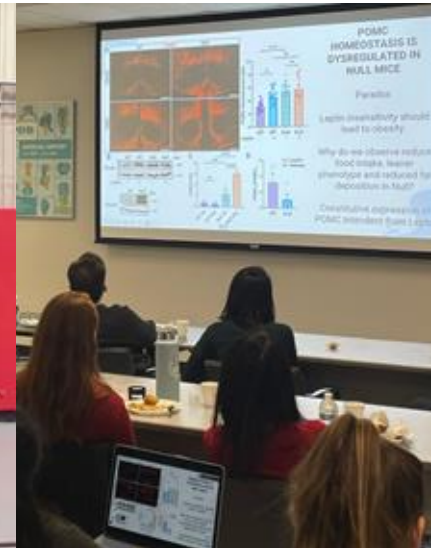


Who - GSO run by and for the Neuroscience PhD students, although all are welcome! Second year students are in charge of E-Board activities and creating events.

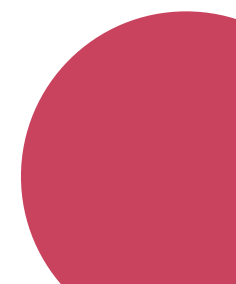
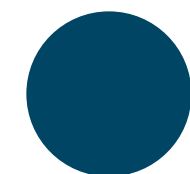
